CBSE RESULT CLASS - XII

I have great pleasure in presenting the CBSE Result of 2023

In 2023 a total of 50 students appeared for AISSCE i.e. class XII. We have two streams Science and Commerce.

Science Stream - Pass percentage was 98%. Ankush thakur Scored the highest percentage 93%.

Commerce Stream - Pass percentage was 98%

Four students from commerce stream appeared for CPT and cleared in the first attempt. Now they are preparing for IPCC.

In class X 50 Students appeared and the result was **100%**. **22 students secured 1st class.**

Recognition & Awards

The true measure of a School's Co-scholastic programme is its participation and meritorious performance in inter school activities. In the year **2023-24** our students participated in various interschool and inter house events, covering a wide range of talent areas and won several prizes. The details of a few commendable achievements are here.

Sports & Games

In sports, this year, we have taken initiative for boosting sports, we appointed coaches in six different disciplines of sports that is Badminton, Table Tennis, Roller Skating, Soft ball, Cricket and Kho-kho. The school has been continuously imparting sports training for Athletics, volley ball, Cricket, Soft Ball, Football, Kho Kho, Taekwondo, Skating ,Badminton, Basket Ball and Table Tennis. More than two hundred students of our school have taken part in various sports out of which 64 students selected for SGFI state level competition and 80 students participated in CBSE cluster level competition. 40 students selected for SGFI and CBSE School national in Taekwondo, Kho-Kho, Athletics, Softball and Skating. Five students secured gold medals and two students secured silver medal in SGFI competitions. In CBSE Clusters our School Kho Kho team, both girls and boys, secured gold medal and became champion and in CBSE national kho kho championship we secured silver medal and became runners up. In the same competition Master Shesh kosma of XII Commerce selected as best player of national kho kho championship held at DPS Sambalpur (Odisha)and recommended for Chacha Nehru award 2016-17 from CBSE New Delhi. In cluster athletic meet held at our school two students secured gold two students secured silver and four students secured bronze medals. In Skating our students secured two gold medals one silver medal and one bronze medal . in CBSE far east zone chess championship our school girls under 11 chess team secured silver medal and qualified for national championship. Last year we constructed four hundred meter Athletic track and this year indoor hall for four courts Badminton and Table Tennis is under construction.

Our school take care of the overall development of the children. They are exposed to maximum co-curricular activities. The students are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and inter school competitions. These help them not only to expose their talents, but also develop their multi dimensional growth.
